
To reach the campus via public transportation, please visit the <u>ATM website</u> (public transit authority of Milan). The campus is serviced by:

- Metro M5 (purple line): train stop "Ponale;"
- Metro M1 (red line): train stop "Precotto" and then Tram 7/direction "Messina,"
- Tram 7: stop "Arcimboldi-Ateneo Nuovo" (underground stop)
- Tram 31: stop "San Glicerio."

How to Get Around Milan by Public Transport

Milan's public transportation system connects the most important areas of the city and more.

Buy tickets (and plan your journey) from the mobile app The official app lets you plan your journey and buy tickets by credit card, PayPal or Satispay. You can check the time-tables, the routes and waiting times in real time of all surface lines and the current status of metro service. Download it from the App Store or click below:



Buy tickets in person Tickets can be bought at the **automatic machines** located in all metro stations or at any **authorized resellers** (find here the list).

Ticket costs (approximate) to travel in and around Milan:

- 2,20€ ticket. Valid 90 minutes
- Daily ticket. Valid 24 hours, 7,60€
- 3 days ticket. 13€
- Carnet 10 tickets. 19,50€

These tickets (Mi1-Mi3 fare zones) are valid on **metro lines**, **buses**, **trams**, **trolleybus**es and are also accepted on **S lines** (suburban railways).

Travel from Linate airport to the city center by metro line M4 or bus 73 The new metro line M4 connects Linate airport to Dateo station, where you can change for suburban railways (<u>S lines</u>). More information about M4 service on <u>this page</u>. Bus line 73 connects the city centre (via Gonzaga, behind piazza del Duomo) with the airport arrival hall doors. Check the departure times <u>from Linate</u> and <u>from Duomo</u>. Pay contactless directly on board or buy a ticket at the ticket machines, in front of the terminal exit. You just need a **Mi1-Mi3 fare** to get on board (standard 2,20€ ticket, daily pass, carnet, etc.).
